Project Description: The scope of work included electrical demolition, temporary power, and new electrical services to the new shipping, storage, production areas, and engine room buildings. Work consisted of duct bank and high voltage service to new transformers, switchgear, and 5000 amp switchboard. Provided power, control, and communication wiring necessary for all lighting, refrigeration systems, electrical panels, elevator, and conveyor systems.
